**From the South:**

From I-93 N, take exit 5B (RT-28 N) toward Milton. Take a slight right onto MA-28/N Main St. Continue to follow MA-28 N. Turn left onto Reedsdale Rd./MA-28. Continue to follow MA-28 N. Turn left onto Morton St. Take a right onto the ramp and keep left at the fork to go on American Legion Highway. Kingbird Road (adjacent to 150 American Legion Highway) will be on your right.

**From the North:**

From I-93 S, take exit 15 (Columbia Rd) toward the J.F.K. Library. Keep right at the fork to go onto Columbia Rd. Turn left onto Blue Hill Ave./MA-28 S. Turn right onto American Legion Highway. Make a U-turn at E Main St. onto American Legion Highway. Kingbird Road (adjacent to 150 American Legion Highway) will be on the right.

**From the West:**

From I-90 E, take exit 14 (I-95 S) toward the South Shore/Cape Cod. Then take exit 20A (MA-9 E) toward Brookline/Boston. Take a slight right onto Boylston St. Take another slight right onto Hammond Pond Parkway. Enter the next roundabout and take the third exit onto Newton St. Turn left to stay on Newton St. which will become Pond St. Turn right onto Arborway/MA-203 E and pass through one roundabout. Enter the next roundabout and take the third exit onto MA-203 E/Morton St. Turn right onto American Legion Highway. Kingbird Road (adjacent to 150 American Legion Highway) will be on the right.

**From Boston:**

From Boston Common, start out going Southeast on Park St. toward Tremont St. Take a right onto Tremont St. Then take a left onto Boylston St. Boylston St. becomes Essex St. Merge onto I-93 S toward Quincy and take exit 15 (Columbia Rd) toward the J.F.K. Library. Keep right at the fork to go onto Columbia Rd. Turn left onto Blue Hill Ave./MA-28 S. Turn right onto American Legion Highway. Make a U-turn at E Main St. onto American Legion Highway. Kingbird Road (adjacent to 150 American Legion Highway) will be on the right.

**Parking:**

Parking is available at 150 American Legion Highway. You will also find on street parking along E. Main Street, just off of Kingbird Road.
